Public Advisory Re: Special Registration Window for New Charities

Hurricane Melissa Response

In response to the impact of Hurricane Melissa on Jamaica, the Department of Cooperatives and Friendly Societies, Charities Authority (DCFS) is facilitating the Special Registration of Registered Charitable Organizations (RCO) to aid in national relief and recovery efforts.

Key Features of the Special Registration window:

Fast-Track Processing:

Applications will be processed within ten (10) working days.

Temporary Registration Period:

Certificates will be issued for the period November 17, 2025 to May 31,2026.

Type of Registered Charitable Organizations:

Only Unincorporated groups will be registered.

Automatic Closure:

All Specially Registered Charitable Organizations will be automatically wound up at May 31, 2026 the end of the six-month period.

Streamlined Process:

Administrative and Operations Management Policies and Procedures will be temporarily waived for this period.

No Renewals Required:

Charitable status is valid for the six-month relief period only and will not be renewed.

Closure of Accounts

All accounts with the DCFS and Tax Administration of Jamaica must be closed at the end of the period.
